Independent contractor disclaimers are to be included on various documents and materials as discussed below. In any of the below disclaimers,

- "the Company" can be substituted with the local company name or brokerage name.
- Include the disclaimer on the cover page or first page of the document or material.
- Where the disclaimer does not fit on the first/cover page, the disclaimer can be included on page 2 after the cover page, as long as it is still prominent.
- In a one-page document, the disclaimer can be put at the bottom of the page, as long as it is still prominent.
- In addition, in a long document, include the disclaimer on the bottom of each page.
- If you find that a disclaimer does not fit a particular scenario, please contact the Independent Contractor (ICR) Department for further guidance.

1. Agent Facing Materials

Include this disclaimer on material the office manager and staff makes available, provides or offers to independent sales associates (*e.g.*, sample business plans, meeting agendas, emails, educational resources, tips, skill building materials, etc.), on a voluntary basis. This disclaimer clearly expresses that use of the material is optional and not required for continued affiliation. In addition, to the extent there is a sign in sheet at an educational event, include this disclaimer on the top of each page.

As an independent contractor sales associate, your participation in or use of any [Company] materials, programs, or meetings is completely voluntary. Your participation in or use is not required for your continued affiliation with the Company.

2. Affiliation/Recruiting Disclaimer (to be used externally)

Include this disclaimer on all recruiting and/or affiliation material. (*e.g.*, recruiting brochures, recruiting/affiliation type letters, paperwork given to ICs to induce him/her to affiliate with the Company).

Any affiliation by you with [Company] is intended to be that of an independent contractor sales associate, not an employee.

Note: If 3rd Party companies (vendors, sales and educational programs, etc.) provide materials to the Independent Contractor sales associates, do not add our Company logo to their materials.
